Types of Assignments in the Grade Book

- Summative** calculating at 65% of overall grade. Examples: a research paper, an oral report with a power point, science fair project, a unit test. Summative assignments are major end of learning tests or projects.
- Formative** calculating at 35% of overall grade. Examples: a three paragraph essay, written responses to questions over an assigned reading. Formative assignments are minor assignments done for learning.
- *Practice – No calculation, set at 0% (OPTIONAL FOR TEACHER USE)**. Assignments are brief. Examples: short student responses, a valid sampling of math problems, keyboarding exercises. Practice assignments are not generally graded for accuracy and are not a part of the grade. Some teachers may include all assignments within Summative and Formative folders.
